

## PRE-SCHOOL











## MORNING ACADEMIC









## LUNCH

Fourth hour begins a two hour lunch period, initiated by the mad rush to be first to pass Stella's punch station; only to receive the nourishment that makes a better student.



## AFTERNOON ACADEMIC






## POST SCHOOL





During the week of homecoming, decorating floats was a common activity.



As the halls empty, the broom and cleaning barrels are unveiled. We find the janitors and their helpers busy at work combating the innumerable upkeeping repairs.








Due to popular demand, Homecoming was informal this year. Squirt provided the music.









# BASKETBALL


# WINTERBALL

"Phred" provided the music, as they had for Prom.








# WRESTLING




The Dairyland Conference Tournament was held at Augusta this year. It proved to be a very successful tournament for the team and their fans.


Our team ranked thirteenth in the state at the close of the season, but to us, they're still #1!


